When I was 16, I was selected to accompany a group of medical professionals on a mission to China through Operation Smile, an organization that provides free medical care around the world for people with facial deformities such as a cleft palate. Many of these patients were unable to perform routine tasks such as eating and drinking and were shunned from their communities because of their deformities. It was truly one of the most remarkable experiences of my life. In a mere two weeks I saw the power of medicine and how physicians and nurses drastically changed lives. The surgeries provided not only allowed them to function on a day-to-day basis but changed their outlook on life. To this day, this experience still warms my heart. It taught me not only the necessity of access to medical care, but the impact it can have on one's life."


